NEW HAVEN, CT. — Susan McCaslin exhibits Totem II in the group show *Art in Windows* in Historic Westville Village, New Haven CT

McCaslin's interest in large rocks and boulders began with her Sunday School's trip to Pennsylvania's historic two-acre diabase boulder field and continued to surface every few years. But it was in 2008 that the legend of the Old Leather Man and his rock shelters peaked her interest in earnest—culminating in drawings, prints, and sculptures of the ancient stones.

Initially McCaslin's focus was on the Old Leather Man himself but eventually she turned her eye to the various elements within the New England landscape and the roles that these elements play in our daily lives of creatures that depend on them for shelter.

Susan McCaslin is a 2012 recipient of an artist fellowship grant from Connecticut's Department of Economic and Community Development. McCaslin is a graduate of Pratt Institute and is currently enrolled in the Graduate Liberal Studies program at Wesleyan University.
